For children 4'10" or under, a 3/4 size acoustic guitar is recommended. This guitar is smaller than a full-sized and thus easier to hold and play. For students 4'11"-5'2", a 7/8 guitar is recommended. Students over 5'2" should be able to play a full-size guitar. Keep in mind, these are just guidelines! If you are unsure, visit a music store to try some out!

****Nylon string guitars are a little easier to start on as they are easier on the fingers. Steel String guitars are the most common but are a tougher on the fingers****
